

CMU 2010 Key Performance Indicators

Key Performance Indicators (KPIs) allow the University community to monitor the extent to which CMU is approaching its organizational and strategic goals. Some of the KPIs represent simple headcounts or figures, while others can be more complex, comparing differences in mean scores taken from a combination of questions found on valid and reliable national surveys.

- KPI 14 - External Grants and Contracts

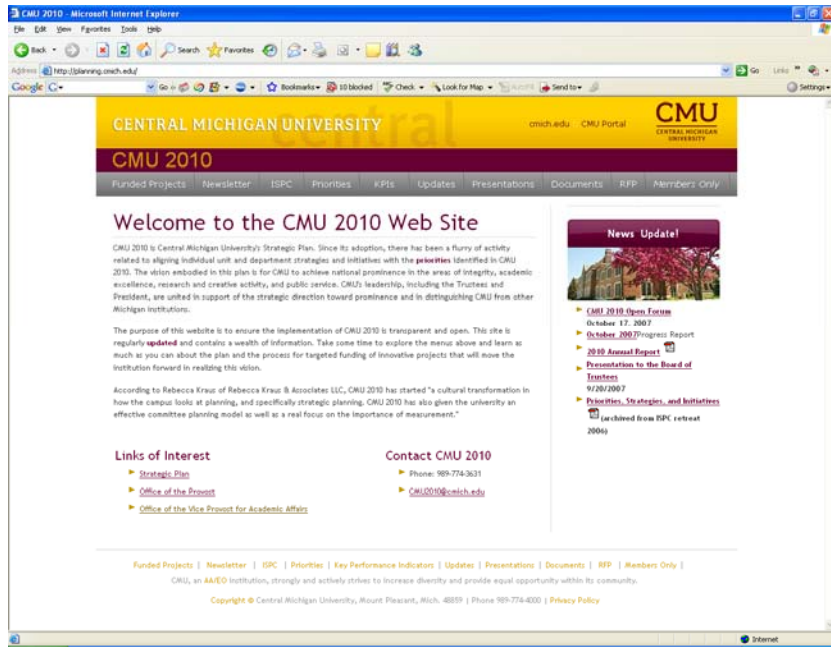
Priority IV - Public Service

- KPI 16 - Student Participation in Community Service

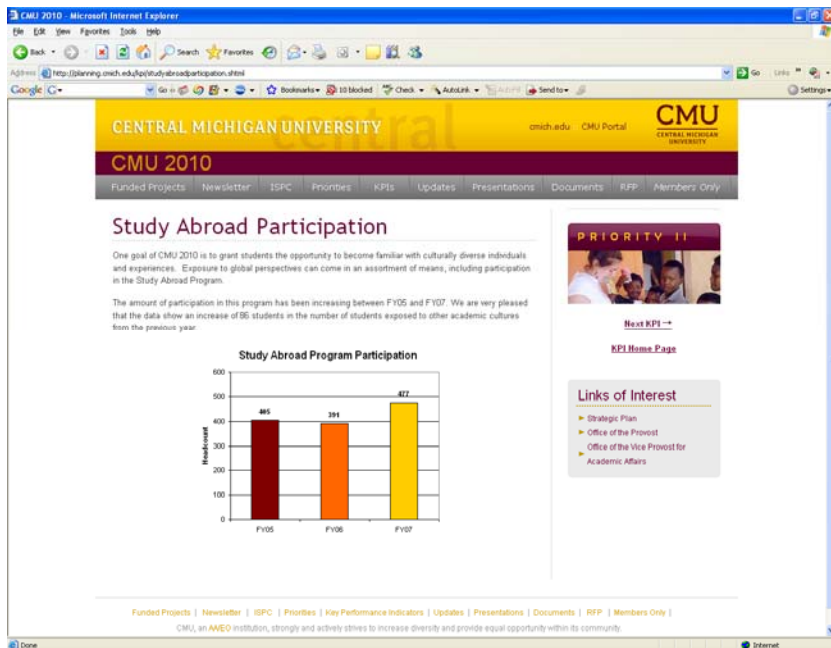
Priority V - Culture of Integrity
