Complete	June 2008	Expand and improve program sessions offered by NAISEC. Sessions will be improved by increasing emphasis on culture and Native American identity. Sessions will be a changing program every four years to accommodate returning students. The revolving sessions will be themed each year. (Ex: STEM academic areas FY08)
<b>3</b>	Getting 11 <sup>th</sup> and 12 <sup>th</sup> grade NAISEC students to apply to CMU with a minimum of 10% of graduating NAISEC applying and being admitted to CMU.	In Progress	June 2008	Continue tracking efforts of graduating NAISEC participants. Send scholarship information to 12 <sup>th</sup> grade students and inform them of outside Native American Scholarships that are offered.
